HARLAN CHECKLIST FOR ANIMALS' HEALTH STATUS

1.	The animal appears alert, mobile and is not isolated from its box mates.	
2.	No squealing on handling.	
3.	Normal coat with no signs of hair loss, staring coat, loss of sheen or staining around perineum.	
4.	Normal number of limbs/eyes/ears.	
5.	Normal appearance of eyes – eyelids not closed, eyes not sunken or glazed; no evidence of nasal or ocular discharge.	
6.	No evidence of hunching.	
7.	Normal respiration with no evidence of panting, laboured breathing, grunting prior to expiration or grating teeth.	
8.	Normal appearance of feaces – no evidence of diarrhoea.	
9.	Normal locomotor activity – no evidence of twitching, fitting, tremors, convulsions, paralysis, shivering, sluggish or absent reflexes. No evidence of unsteady gait, lameness, muscle flaccidity, rigidity or weakness.	
10.	No abnormal swellings or protrusions.
