## Offline Processing of Airyscan Data

- 1. Store your airyscan images direct on the HIVE, which should be mounted at H: in your profile, during acquisition
  - a. Use path H:\ Airyscan\_processing\Input
  - b. In order to have it automatically processed the file **MUST** 
    - i. Be an czi format
    - ii. Include "Airyscan." (note the dot!) in the filename
  - If you want to force 2D processing (if you have suboptimal sampling) the name must also contain ".2D" (note the dot!)

Example 3D: H:\Airyscan\_processing\Input\Airyscan.pPE85\_FM.czi Example 2D: H:\Airyscan\_processing\Input\Airyscan.2D\_tissue.czi

- 2. The *processing* is done automatically.
  - a. The processed original file is moved to the directory "processed"
  - b. The processed result file is moved to the directory "output"

Both files get the date and time put in front.

Example 3D: H:\Airyscan\_processing\Processed\151201\_135649\_Airyscan.pPE85\_FM.czi

H:\Airyscan processing\Output\151201 135648 Airyscan Processed.pPE85 FM.czi

Example 2D: H:\Airyscan processing\Processed\151201 135648 Airyscan Processed.pPE85 FM.czi

H:\Airyscan\_processing\Output\151201\_135912\_Airyscan\_Processed.2D\_tissue.czi

- 3. *Transfer* your processed files:
  - a. Access your files from any computer by using the following path:

\\hive-impimba-1\PROJECTS\Airyscan\_processing\Output \\hive-impimba-1\PROJECTS\Airyscan\_processing\Processed

- b. Transfer the processed files to your favorite storage location
- 4. DELETE all your files on the HIVE

## Important:

- It is not necessary to store the original date (whatever is finally in the "processed"- Folder)!! There are usually no reasons to reprocess Airyscan data and they are very large.
- Files on the HIVE older than 14days can be removed without notice, so make sure you always transfer
  your data after processing
